

## "MAGIC OF HARP" Evelyn Huber - Harp Solo

Immerse yourself in the world of harp sounds!

Exceptional harpist Evelyn Huber (formerly Quadro Nuevo) is a special sound experience on her harp: devotedly fiery as well as atmospherically meditative. Inspired by tango, jazz, new classics and Latin American lifestyle, she develops a unique musical style that is carried by her sunny temperament and her dedication to music.

Awarded the Bavarian Culture Prize and double Echo winner ("Best Live Act of the Year" together with the band Quadro Nuevo, of which she was a member for 12 years), she jams, hums, buzzes, whistles and swings on the harp and intones artfully interwoven melodies at a fast tempo. From time to time, however, she flirts and enchants on the most delicate angelic strings.

With her charm, joy of playing and technical perfection, the exceptional artist unfolds fascinating worlds of sound and takes her audience on an exciting musical journey far removed from the usual harp cliché - unexpected and surprising. **The entertaining and amusing concert is presented by the harpist herself - supplemented with one or two amusing stories from her touring life"**

Evelyn Huber studied harp at the University of Music and Performing Arts Munich and graduated with a master class diploma. From 1998 to 2009 she worked there as a lecturer for harp. In 2007 she was appointed visiting professor at the Guildhall School of Music London.

Very early on, she began to explore the musical possibilities of the concert harp and to transcend conventional boundaries. Jazz studies in the USA, concert activities all over the world with various ensembles and, last but not least, her solo performances have made her a virtuoso in the genres of jazz and world music.
